The BYU Management Society Scholarship: The BYU Management Society – Salt Lake City Chapter will be awarding scholarship in Spring 2020. Amounts from **\$1,000** to **\$3,000** depending on need and merit. Candidates should demonstrate financial need, academic excellence, leadership, meaningful community and/or religious service. You do **NOT** need to be a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints or have an affiliation with BYU. You may use this scholarship at an accredited college or university in Utah, including trade/technical schools or any LDS college or university.

Bertin Family Foundation Scholarship: The Bertin Family Foundation Scholarship was established with the graduating class of 2009 at Bountiful High School. Kim and Jennifer Bertin want to reward good students who don't receive a major scholarship despite great effort. The Foundation contributes \$2,000 a year for four eligible years toward the recipient's education (a total of \$8,000!) This scholarship is for a current senior at BHS that has a 3.3 GPA and a score greater than 22 on the ACT. You should be able to demonstrate extensive leadership/extra-curricular/service experience, have been accepted into a college/university, and have not received another significant scholarship (half-tuition or more disqualifies applicants). DEADLINE: April 10, 2020

Bountiful Rotary Scholarship: Bountiful Rotary Club is offering FIVE, \$1,000 scholarships to seniors at Bountiful High School. This scholarship has an emphasis on service, school involvement, academic potential and leadership. For an application, please see Kathy Anderson in the scholarship office.

DEADLINE: March 27, 2020

Italian-American Civic League Scholarship: The Women's Italian American Civic League and Men's Italian American Civic League are awarding two (2) \$1,000 scholarships. An applicant must be of Italian ancestry and a 2020 graduate of a Utah high school. The scholarships are awarded based on the ACT, extracurricular activities, and exceptional high school ability. Scholarships are awarded by both the Men's and Women's Chapters of the IACL. Both male and females are encouraged to apply for both scholarships, but **cannot receive both awards** per IACL bylaws. DEADLINE: March 15, 2020

Utah JumpStart Spring 2020 Scholarship: This scholarship competition is designed to recognize students who can demonstrate a solid understanding of financial literacy concepts and are pursuing a post-secondary education either at a university, college, trade school, or similar institution of higher learning. There are three (3) \$1,250 scholarships available. Student must submit a 60-second video about paying for college as part of the application.
