Must be a high school senior graduating from a school in Colorado, New Mexico, **UTAH**, or Wyoming. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a minimum ACT score of 18. The applicant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must have an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less on the 2020 tax return on which the applicant is claimed as a dependent.
