Horatio Alger Scholarship: State scholarships are awarded to eligible students who have faced and overcome great obstacles in their young lives. Applicants must be enrolled full time as a high school senior, exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree, demonstrate critical financial need, be involved in co-curricular and community service activities.

DEADLINE: October 26, 2020

Voice of Democracy Essay Competition: Students compete by writing and recording an audio essay on an annual patriotic theme. This year's theme is, **Is This the Country the Founders Envisioned?** Department (State) winners receive an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. and a minimum scholarship of \$1,000. Elks Most Valuable Student Contest: The 2021 Most Valuable Student scholarship contest is open to any high school senior who is a US citizen. Applicants DO NOT need to be related to a member of the Elks. Applicants will be judged on leadership, academic achievements, community involvement, and financial need.

Zion's Pays for A's Scholarship: Students ages 12-18 are eligible and must have a Zion's Bank Young Savers Account. Students bring in their most recent report card and receive a \$1 deposit for every A on their report card. Zion's Bank also hold three drawings every year for a \$100 savings account deposit and one grand prize drawing annually for a \$1,000 scholarship savings account.

Utah Jumpstart Scholarship: This scholarship competition is designed to recognize students who can demonstrate a solid understanding of financial literacy concepts and are pursuing a post-secondary education either at a university, college, trade school or similar institution of higher learning.
