It can be used at all public or private institutions in Utah that offer an approved program including Brigham Young University, Dixie State University, Salt Lake Community College, Snow College, Southern Utah University, University of Utah, Utah Valley University, Weber State University, Western Governors University, and Westminster college. (Seniors) Heisman Scholarships: Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better, be proven leaders and role models within their school and community, must participate or have participated in grades 9,10, or 11 in at least one of the 48 school sponsored sports recognized by the International Olympic Committee in the Summer and Winter Olympic Games or the National Federation of State High School Associations.
