Students receive a \$2,000 annual stipend for up to four years (can be deferred for up to two years), a funded global learning experience as part of their third year required lab, and opportunities to participate in curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular experiences. Students are assigned professional mentors on Day 1 and have the opportunity to build meaningful relationships with faculty, staff, alumni, and fellow students through specially designed activities.
